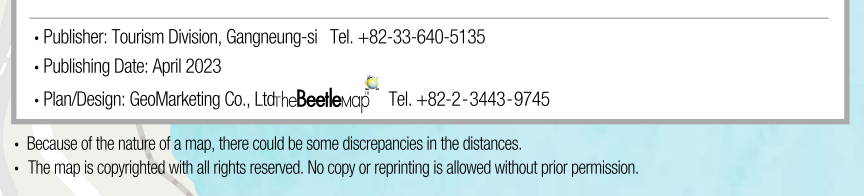


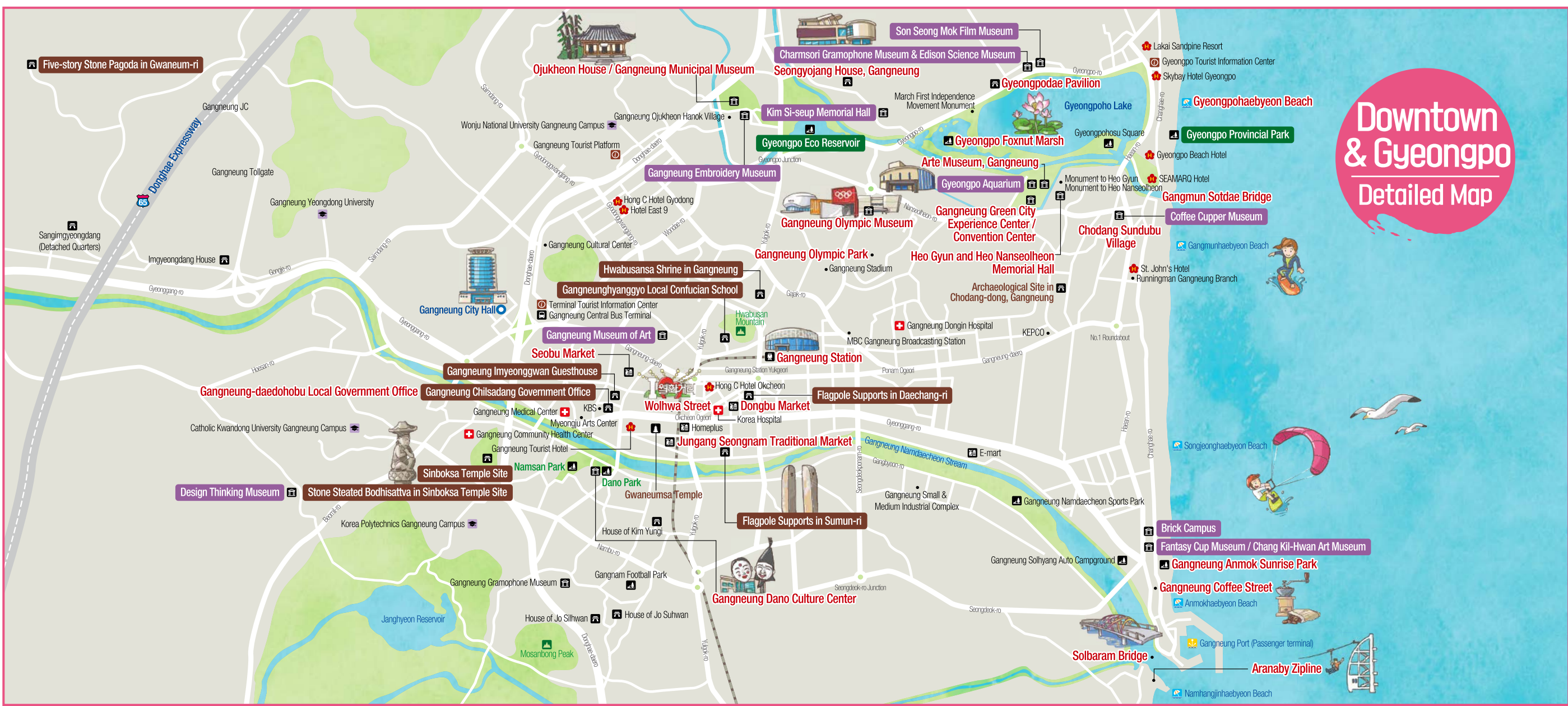

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## Gangneung Main Attractions

### 1 Jumunjin Port



Jumunjin Port, one of the main fishing ports on the east coast, is where about 350 fishing boats come and go, and because of the nature of the East Sea, where warm and cold currents meet, squid, sand eel, pollock, herring, and anchovy are caught in large numbers. You can also enjoy freshly caught fish in the area at reasonable prices.

### 2 BTS Bus Stop



A bus stop that is featured in the album jacket photo of Bangtan Sonyeondan, popularly known as BTS, the first Korean pop group to top the US Billboard album chart. This film shooting spot became immensely popular among both domestic and foreign BTS fans, and is emerging as a unique attraction at Jumunjinhaebyeon and Hyanghoahaeyeon Beaches.

### 3 Gyeongpohosu Lake



Gyeongpohosu Lake is popular for its cherry blossom and pine trails nearby. Every season, the lake offers magnificent views, yet the most stunning scenery is in the early summer when lotus flowers are in full bloom. This lake is surrounded by a bike path, so you can rent a bicycle or a four-wheeler for a scenic ride around the lake.

### 4 Wolhwa Street



Starting from Gangneung Station, Wolhwa Street is a walking path through the downtown area. The street was built along an abandoned railroad, and is named Wolhwa based on the love story of "Muwilling and Madam Wonhwa," a folk tale in Gangneung. Beautiful sculptures installed along the street, which are in good harmony with the alleys, also became a popular attraction.

### 5 Gangneung Coffee Street



There is a row of cafes, small or large, along Anmokhaebyeon Beach, where you can enjoy coffee and the sea. As skilled baristas began to settle in from 1990, the coffee street was naturally created and became a tourist destination representing the city of Gangneung.

### 6 Jeongdongjin Railbike



Running the course between Jeongdongjin Station and Moraesigye Park, the Jeongdongjin Railbike offers an unobstructed view of the ocean, a sandy beach, and the sound of waves. Besides the railbike, you can also visit the observatory, Time Museum, and Hourglass Park.

### 7 Jeongdong-simgok Badabuchaegil Trail



This trail, consisting of a terrace topography at Jeongdongjinhaebyeon Beach, was designated as Natural Monument No. 437 because it is the largest and most preserved marine terrace in Korea. A 2.86 km-long trail, connecting Jeongdongjin to Simgok Port, has a towering marine terrace, and from the trail, you can enjoy the magnificent scenery of the ocean waves across the Jeongdongjinhaebyeon Beach.

### 8 Gangneung Solhyang Arboretum



The arboretum covering about 240,000 pyeong (approx. 0.8 km<sup>2</sup>) has a variety of themes. From the entrance, you can enjoy the scent of flowers, pine trees, and the sound of a flowing stream. The arboretum includes the Eco Trail with a colony of spicewood and snowbell, the Thousand-Year Healing Trail, the Pine Forest Plaza filled with red pine trees, and an exhibition garden with various themes of wild flowers.

### 9 Majeongtapgil Trail in Nachusan Mountain



The trail, about 1.2 km long, has more than 3,000 stone towers in the foothills of Nachusan Mountain. The towers contain a story of an old mother who stacked stones in the hope of peace and stability for her child and family. On this trail, you can leisurely take a stroll while enjoying warm-hearted feelings in nature.

### 10 Sojeumgangsansan Mountain



Sojeumgangsansan Mountain, designated as Sonic Site No. 1, is located in Odasan National Park. In 1569, Yi I (gen name: Yulgok) traveled to Cheonghaeksan Mountain and named the mountain Sojeumgangsansan in his book Trip to Cheonghamsan Mountain. In 2021, after some sections of the Sojeumgangsansan Trail were restored by the Odasan National Park office and Yulgok Institute, the trail was renamed the "1569 Yulgok Heritage Trail."

## Theme Tour Course

### History Tour Offering History and Atmosphere in Gangneung

Imyeonggwang Guesthouse, built in the 19th year of the reign of King Tsep of the Goryeo Dynasty, features Jeondaejeong Hall, where wooden tablets of the kings were enshrined and ceremonies were held. The guesthouse also has buildings on both sides to provide accommodation for officials visiting Gangneung.

Seongyojeang House features a typical upper-class residence in the Joseon period. The house consists of Donghyeoddaeng (East Detached Quarters), Yeodaejeong Hall, Hwaljeong Pavilion, and a shrine. It has been well-preserved with about 8,000 relics, including household tools, artworks, clothes, etc.

### Eco and Culture Trail in Gyeongpo

The Eco Marsh Park was built to restore and preserve the ecosystem of the lake around Gyeongpo, and to create an environment inhabited by a variety of aquatic plants and wildlife. As well as an open plaza for visitors, the park has facilities for observing the wetland ecosystem.

As the only marine terrace in Korea, the trail has been designated as Natural Monument No. 437. This trail features the unexplored beauty of the East Sea's blue waves and oddity formed rocks.

This park has the world's biggest hourglass. Each part of the hourglass has its own meaning: the upper part of the hourglass represents the future; the flowing sand represents the present; the golden circular shape represents the sun rising over the East Sea; and the parallel rail tracks symbolize the infiniteness of time.

Serving as an educational center for unification and security, Gangneung Unification Park is the first place in Korea to exhibit military equipment from all three-armed forces. Along with the Jeongdongjin sunrise tourist site, the park helps stimulate the local economy.

## Foods of Gangneung

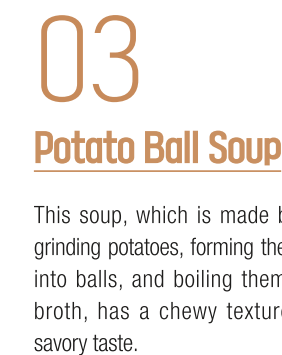
### 01 Cold Raw Fish Soup

This cold raw fish soup is made by putting fresh seafood and vegetables in a bowl with pear juice and icy plum broth, giving a touch of sweet, sour, and spicy flavors.



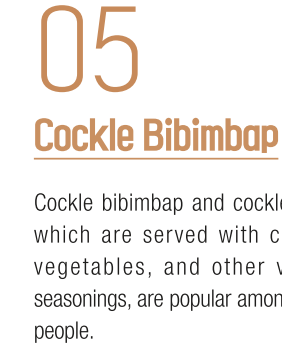
### 02 Spicy Noodle Soup

You can enjoy the spicy flavor by boiling the noodle soup with soybean paste and red pepper paste.



### 04 Spicy Seafood Soup with Soft Bean Curd

This soup offers a new food experience by combining soft bean curd, a typical dish in Chodang, with spicy seafood soup, which allows you to enjoy fresh seafood and a spicy taste.



### 05 Cockle Bibimbap

Cockle bibimbap and cockle salad, which are served with cockles, vegetables, and other various seasonings, are popular among young people.

### 06 Soft Bean Curd Gelato

As a dessert, this gelato is made of soft bean curd, one of the representative dishes in Gangneung, giving you a sweet and savory taste.



### 07 Coffee

Gangneung is known as "the coffee city," to the extent that a coffee street is formed where cafes gather to form a street, where you can enjoy special coffees such as corn coffee, potato coffee, etc.



### 08 Bread

There are many distinctive breads that originated from Gangneung and became popular across the nation. You can find unique breads such as coffee bean bread, bean-powder-coated cream bread, and jjampong bread (spicy-seafood-noodle-soup flavored).



### 09 Food in Traditional Market

In the market, you can enjoy a variety of food, such as "deep-fried and braised chicken" with sweet and sour flavor, "grilled galbi patties" seasoned in pork cutlet, bulgogi, or BBQ-flavored sauces according to your tastes; and "beef head meat and rice soup" with delicious, rich flavor.

## Festivals of Gangneung



### 04 April Gyeongpo Cherry Blossom Festival

This festival is held on the 4.3 km road along the Gyeongpohosu Lake during spring, with Gyeongpodae Pavilion as a center.



### 06 June Gangneung Danoje (Dano Festival of Gangneung)

Designated as Important Intangible Cultural Heritage No. 13, this traditional folk festival was put on the representative list of Intangible Heritage of Humanity by UNESCO.
